

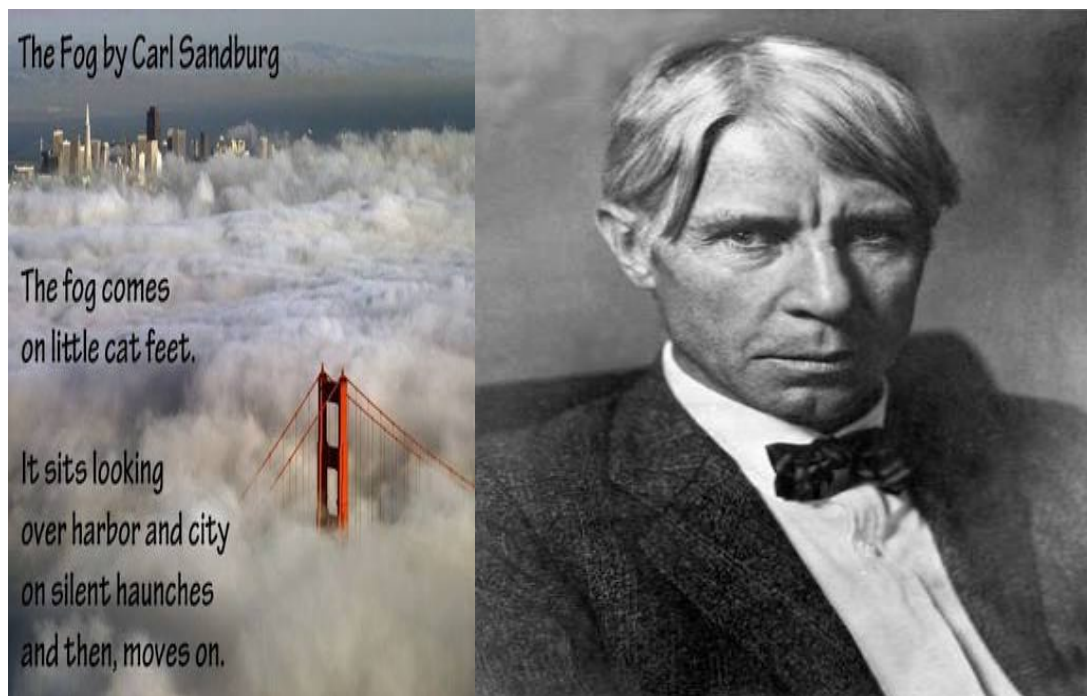

The poem fog by Carl Sandburg first appeared in his first mainstream collection of poems entitled Chicago Poems. Which was published in the year 1916.

In this short poem, the poem describes the coming and going of fog by using the metaphor of a cat. A cat comes and goes away without making the slightest noise so does the fog. The poet actually says that the fog is like

a cat. It comes quietly like a cat. It stays a little while looking all around. It sits on its haunches like a cat. Then it moves on as quietly as it had come.
